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Notice to voters: If you are voting on Election Day, your ballot must be initiated by 2 election inspectors. If you are voting absentee, your ballot must be initiated by the municipal clerk or deputy clerk. Your ballot may not be counted without initials. (See end of ballot for initials.)

General Instructions If you make a mistake on your ballot or have a question, ask a poll worker for help. (Absentee voters: contact your municipal clerk.) To vote for a name on the ballot, fill in the oval next to the name like this: ●. To vote for a name that is not on the ballot, write the name on the line marked "write-in" and fill in the oval next to the name like this: ●. Special Instructions for Voting in a Partisan Primary In the Partisan Primary: - You may vote in only ONE party's primary. - If you choose a party, votes cast in that party will be counted. Votes cast in any other party will not be counted. - If you do not choose a party and you vote in more than one party, no votes will be counted. You must vote for individual candidates.
